The Mauritius Institute of Education (MIE) is the only institution responsible for teacher education in Mauritius. MIE was established “to provide facilities and to engage in educational research, curriculum development and teacher education and thereby to promote the advancement of learning and knowledge in the field of education and, in particular, to provide teacher education responsive to the social, linguistic, administrative, scientific, agricultural and technological needs of Mauritius” (The Mauritius Institute of Education Act, 1973).

Staff from MIE has contributed in:

- (i) Teacher Education and Curriculum development at pre-primary, primary, secondary and tertiary levels in Mauritius
- (ii) Educational research at both national and international level.
- (iii) Textbook production at all levels of education.
- (iv) Consultancy services to various bodies in the educational and other sectors.
